2010 BRIDAL BOUQUET DESIGN CONTEST RULES

- All entries must use only fresh flowers and foliages plus embellishments and mechanics. No silks please.
- Include wholesale costs of all flowers, foliages, mechanics and embellishments used in bouquet not to exceed \$50.00.
- Your bouquet will be displayed on a pedestal 12"x12" top, variety of heights available (first come first choice).
- Display as you would like your bride to first see her dream bouquet. (Note: Judges must be able to pick up bouquets. Display props will not be judged.) No electricity will be provided but battery operated devices are allowed.
- Provide a 3x5 card briefly describing your bride. Please print to be read easily.
- All entrants must abide by these guidelines. Any violation will be grounds for disqualification
- Judging will concentrate on:
 1. Creativity and Originality
 2. Basic design principles (balance, scale, focal, color, line, movement, etc.)
 3. Interpretation of theme
 4. Mechanics and degree of difficulty
- Judging will be on a 10 point scale. In event of a tie, judges will reevaluate the tied entries considering only artistic expression.
- The final phase of the competition will be announcement of the top three designs earning the most points.
